

ORDINANCE No. 169 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 36, AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE CITY OF COLOME, SOUTH DAKOTA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

Section 35. In order that the street department may efficiently clean the streets in the City of Colome, it shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle, equipment, trailer, or anything that would prevent the plowing of a street after a snow fall of three (3) inches or more until such time that the street department has plowed the street. Any vehicle not removed before the city has plowed may be cited for a violation of this section. Any vehicle not moved within 12 hours after the City has plowed the street may be ticketed and towed. The owner thereof, in addition to the other penalties prescribed for the violation of a city ordinance, shall be required to pay the cost of towing, removal and storage of said vehicle. A reasonable effort will be made to contact the owner prior to removing the vehicle.
