

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE FIXING TIME AND PLACE FOR REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLOME, AND PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLOME, SOUTH DAKOTA, AND THE BUSINESS TO BE TRANSACTED THEREAT".

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Colome, Tripp County, South Dakota:

Section 1. That the regular meetings of the Common Council of the City of Colome, shall be held on the first and third Tuesdays of each month, at the hour of Eight o'clock P.M. That the place of regular meetings shall be in the council chamber, of the city hall of said City of Colome.

Section 2. That upon the request of two or more members of the Common Council, the Mayor shall call a special meeting of the city council. Said call shall specify the business to be transacted thereat. If all members are present at said special meeting, other business than that specified in the call may be transacted.

Section 3. The Mayor may at any time call a special meeting of the City Council upon written notice of the meeting, and the time, place and purpose thereof being given to each of the Aldermen of said city. Upon consent of a majority of the members of said city council present at such meeting, any business may be transacted thereat.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force twenty (20) days from and after its passage, approval and publication.
